
TOOLS REQUIRED

- Small flat blade screwdriver
- Phillips screwdriver


Attention! With the key out of the ignition, disconnect the negative battery terminal before installing this product. Ensure that all installation connections are secure before cycling the ignition to test this product.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

- Unclip and remove entire panel surrounding radio and a/c control all the way over to left side of steering wheel. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove (5) Phillips screws securing the radio and pocket assembly. (Figure B)







- Remove (2) Phillips screws (1 per side) securing factory pocket to radio/pocket bracket assembly.(Figure C, D)
- **4.** Remove the Hazard/Airbag button from the factory radio panel and set aside for kit assembly.





KIT ASSEMBLY


- Attach the **pocket brackets** to the **radio** housing using the included carriage
 bolts and Keps nuts. (Figure A)
- Position the pocket into the assembled radio housing/pocket assembly and secure with the included hardware to mount pocket (not factory). (Figure B)
- Slide the radio brackets into the radio housing, aligning the slots in the radio housing with the tabs on the radio brackets. (Figure C)





- Slide the radio into the completed assembly and secure it using screws supplied with the radio. (Figure D)
- 5. Install the Hazard/Airbag button removed during dash disassembly into the **pocket**. (Figure E)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXXESS.
- 7. Mount the new radio assembly into the dash and reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.
